

IndexConvert Licences

A range of licences is available to suit individual needs. When first downloaded an internal licence is applied which allows a user to convert up to 10 indexes, each with up to 100 entries subject to an overall maximum of 500 entries. This supports initial familiarization.

A range of licences are available to match likely needs, ranging from low quantity reserve licences intended for casual users to high quantity 5 year licences for power users. These define an 'average' index size, quantity and an expiry date. The index size and quantity are multiplied and define a maximum number of paragraphs that can be processed in the period appropriate to the licence.

	Licence Parameter	Description
a	Licence Period	One year for 1 year or 5 year licences 3 years for Reserve licences.
b	Metrics reset	January for 1 year and 5 year licences. Not applicable for reserve licences.
b	Index size	The size of an average index likely to be processed.
c	Index quantity	The maximum number of indexes permitted.
d	=b x c	The maximum number of entries (paragraphs) that can be processed in the licence period.
e	Expiry date	Expiry date is the 28 th of the month with a 10 day safety margin.

Other licences are supplied by special request, these include short term licences for evaluation or training and reset licences that reset the usage metrics when loaded.

When choosing a 1 year or 5 year licence it is recommended that you choose one rated at twice your expected annual usage.
